Delicate aromas of lemon and Camembert make for a finely balanced wine with a soft fresh finish.

1 Broken Shackle Classic White, Australia	£2.50	£3.50	£5.00	£15.00
A blend of Semillon Chardonnay and Chenin Blanc that produces a fresh, intense wine that is light and crisp. The aromas follow suit with lemon, melon and pears. A vibrant palate gives way to a clean finish.				
3 Sauvignon Blanc Tierra Antica, Chile	£2.70	£3.75	£5.35	£16.00
Light and delicate yellow in colour, with delicious aromas of melon, apple & grapefruit. The palate is as charismatic, with passion fruit and mineral characteristics appearing. A fresh and fruity wine.				
4 Pinot Grigio Capito, Italy	£2.85	£4.00	£5.70	£17.00
Fresh and well structured, with a fine, delicate and slightly spicy bouquet to complement its mineral tones.				
2 Peter Lehman Weighbridge Chardonnay, Australia	£3.00	£4.20	£6.00	£18.00
Soft fruit gives a generous middle palate, balanced by a delightfully crisp acidity and a long finish with lingering peach flavours.				

Red

6 Broken Shackle Classic Red, Australia	£2.50	£3.50	£5.00	£15.00
A blend of Barbera and Shiraz give a very drinkable wine. Lifted aromas of cherries and spice are followed by a palate of rich berry fruit mingled with soft oak, with a lasting finish.				
7 Merlot Tierra Antica, Chile	£2.70	£3.75	£5.35	£16.00
Made with hand picked grapes, this is a soft, round approachable wine. Strong notes of blackberry fruit are present in both the nose and the palate, and the finish is balanced and pleasing.				
8 Hazy View Pinotage, South Africa	£3.00	£4.20	£6.00	£18.00
The wine is clean, bright ruby in colour. On the nose lots of brambly fruit flavours. On the palate the wine is medium bodied with an easy drinking style. The aftertaste is fruity, with a pleasant lively finish.				
9 Shiraz Spitting Spider, Australia	£3.00	£4.20	£6.00	£18.00
Shows ripe red and black fruit characters with hints of liquorice and nutmeg, coupled with a little vanilla and smokiness from the oak. On the palate rich red berry fruits complement soft and rounded tannins.

Champagnes

- 34 Beaumont Creyères Grande Reserve Brut (Champagne)** NV France £42.00
A dominant nose is followed by a refreshing palate with a firm structure. The toasty style has a lemon-herbal character and plenty of acidity and a hint of yeast which comes from ageing in the bottle.
- 35 Moutard Père et Fils Prestige Rosé (Champagne)** NV France £47.00
Lovely salmon pink colour with fine bubbles. Soft but fresh on the palate, with strawberry and raspberry notes. Quite a long, crisp finish without any bitterness
- 36 Veuve Cliquot Brut Yellow Label (Champagne)** NV France £65.00
This classical dry Champagne is loved all over the world for its crisp, full flavours, consistent quality and celebratory yellow label. With hints of apricot, peach and vanilla, and a snappy acidity, this is a fine Champagne

White Wines

- 11 Gewurztraminer Verdelho, Opal Ridge** 2009 Australia £20.00
A wine which combines the aromatic Gewurztraminer grape with the fuller bodied Verdelho to produce a vibrant and fresh tasting wine. Medium-dry in style, aromatic but brimming with soft ripe fruit flavours.
- 12 Foundstone Chardonnay Viognier (Eden Valley)** 2010 Australia £21.00
The Chardonnay offers aromas of ripe stone fruit, peach and nectarine while Viognier contributes a touch of apricot, orange blossom & rose petal that gives an extra dimension to this blend. The palate is full bodied with rich, ripe fruit and spicy vanilla and oak with a long and satisfying finish.
- 13 Rioja Blanco, Monasterio de Yuso** 2010 Spain £21.00
On the nose, this wine shows intense aromas of fresh fruit such as peach and pineapple. On the palate, it is refreshing with a good acidity and a pleasant long finish.
- 15 Chenin Blanc, Mulderbosch (Stellenbosch)** 2009 South Africa £23.00
A clean, fresh, lively wine, well balanced and elegant with great structure and a powerful finish. Floral and tropical fruit aromas combined with lively lemon and lime flavours and a subtle hint of spice.
- 17 Echeverria Chardonnay Reserva** 2007 Chile £26.00
This complex Chardonnay combines aromas of ripe peaches & pineapples with hints of dried fruits, walnuts and honey. Round and balanced, it has a fresh palate with toffee flavours and a long tasty finish.
- 18 Momo Sauvignon Blanc, Seresin Estate (Malborough)** 2009 New Zealand £27.00
Classic unoaked, mineral and crisp gooseberry fruit give a real sense of poise and elegance to this wine. Harvested in the cool mornings of early autumn, the aromatic, intense flavours are followed by a lingering graceful finish embody the qualities of a classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.

Red Wines

- 22 'Feudi d'Albe' Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC** 2008 Italy £20.00
Intense ruby red in colour, this full flavoured wine from the the Abruzzo region of central Italy is pleasantly dry. It has a hint of liquorice and a bouquet reminiscent of wild berries.
- 24 Klein Steenberg Constantia** 2008 South Africa £22.00
A blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc, this wine is similar to a Bordeaux. It is easy drinking, medium bodied with distinct ripe berry aromas, complemented by gentle oak. These aromas are carried through onto the palate creating a well-balanced, structured wine.
- 25 'Coleccion' Pinot Noir, Michel Torino** 2010 Argentina £23.00
Slightly ruby red with violet notes, full earthy aromas of raspberry and ash. The palate has a soft and velvety texture, Fresh jammy flavours with notes of wild flowers, and a smooth dry finish.
- 21 Grand Reserve de Beau Rivage (Bordeaux)** 2008 France £24.00
A typical Bordeaux at an excellent price, this wine has a cedar nose with full ripe red berry fruit flavours enriched by vanillin oak, with a full taste and a mellow finish
- 23 Rioja Crianza Anares** 2008 Spain £25.00
On the nose, this is a very complex wine that shows a combination of fruit, spices and oak influence. On the palate, it is meaty and perfectly structured with a good concentration of ripe fruit.
- 26 Duckbill Shiraz (Great Southern)** 2007 Australia £26.00
The fruit is rich and concentrated with blackberry and woodland notes. There is a hint of dark chocolate and spice on the long supple finish. If that's not enough, who can resist the name.
- 27 Echeverria Merlot Reserva** 2006 Chile £28.00
Grown on ungrafted selected clones of pre-phylloxera French rootstock, this ruby red wine has intense aromas of blackberries and cherries with notes of cassis, mint and pepper.
- 28 Cairanne, Cotes du Rhone Villages** 2007 France £29.00
From Domaine de l'Ameillaud, 20% Syrah and 10% Carignan grapes are added to the 70% Grenache. Spicy plum and red berry fruits are backed by a warm earthiness and a delicious peppery finish.
- 29 Carmen Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva** 2008 Chile £34.00
A rich and full-bodied wine, with a powerful nose of blackcurrant, cocoa and tobacco leaf. Robust and weighty on the palate, with firm tannins surrounding a core of dark fruit.
- 30 Altimus, Michel Torino** 2007 Argentina £45.00
Altimus means 'the highest' in Latin reflecting the height of the vineyards in The Andes. Malbec, Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon and Bonardo Bottled are blended unfiltered allowing, Altimus to express ripe plums, cherries, raisins and other dry fruits, with an exceptional tannic balance that leave a long and very velvety finish.

37 Berton Reserve Botrytis Semillon (375 ml)	2009	Australia	£25.00
It shows intense aromas of orange rind, apricot and honey. The palate bounces with orange, grapefruit and honey flavours with a beautifully balanced and persistent finish.			£7.00 (100ml)

Malt Whisky

We have an extensive collection of over 40 single malt whiskies which are all listed in our Malt Whisky List, but if you don't want the distraction of the choice, here are a few suggestions for an after dinner malt

35ml

The "A" - our house malt - a ten year old Speyside	£3.50
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Rich and mellow with ripe fruit and toffee/fudge aromas. The fruitiness continues on the palate with a vanilla sweetness and delicate hint of smoke.

Secret Stills Islay 1994	£5.00
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A special bottling from the oldest distillery on Islay. Fresh and fruity, with a subtle sweet smoke nose (smoked cheese) and a delicate hint of liquorice.

Secret Stills Highland 1988	£5.00
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A special bottling from a distillery founded in 1797 in Oldmeldrum. Sweet vanilla aromas with hints of candy floss accompany peaches and nectarines with some new wood aromas.

Secret Stills Lowland 1991	£5.00
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A special bottling of whisky that was triple distilled at the foot of the Kilpatrick Hills. Some mulled fruit notes - prunes, figs and raisins. A hint of fresh mint emerges with some dark chocolate influences.
